The child care service in a children's group is provided by the provider with partial reimbursement of costs.

Service prices:

1. 4000,-CZK in case that:

the parent of child who takes parental leave will submit one of the certificates below on the day the child joins the group:

- certificate of employment incl. working hours,
- certificate of business activity,
- confirmation from the employment office, he/she is actively looking for the job,
- certificate of study

and at the same time these conditions are met:

- a) the child and at least one parent have a permanent residence in Prague 4, (see a list of streets at www.zzpraha4.cz)
- b) at least one of the parents runs a business in Prague 4. (see a list of streets at www.zzpraha4.cz)
- 2. 10 000,-CZK in other cases.

The price incl.

any length of stay of the child Mo-Fri 6:30 – 17:00 except public holidays. Does not incl.

food in the amount of 40,-CZK per day, charged back every month according to the actual stay.

Notice:

- if the child is younger than 2 years and goes to the group for more than 92 hours a week you lose the right to parental allowance,
- we only admit a child who is properly vaccinated or who has proof that he/she is immune to the infection or cannot be vaccinated for permanent contraindications.

Exercise activities with children take place throughout the day in the playroom and in the garden.

Staying outside

Outdoor activities take place in the garden /garden taken care of by a janitor/. Sandpit is being disinfected by 2% chloramine twice a year on Friday afternoon and drenched in water on Monday morning. It is covered by a black foil in case of higher temperatures outside. It is covered by a net all year round as a protection against animals. Sandpit is watered as needed. Change of sand in the sandpit is done 1x in 2 years.

Length of time the children spend in the garden depends on a season and weather conditions.

Relaxation and sleep

Children aged 12 - 18 month are having two sleeping periods / according to individual needs /. Children 18 months and older sleep from 12:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m. / according to individual needs /. Children are sleeping in a bedroom, where each child has his/her own folding bed / not being folded / cot / educational bed.

Bedrooms are aired in the morning, as well as during the day.

Every child has his/her own pajama basket. The parents will change the pajama once per week, or more often, if needed.

Bedsheets are changed once per 14-21 days, in case of urgent need immediately. Beds are made up after thorough airing. Beds are marked with the child's mark.

Children's hygiene and personal hygiene

- a/ before every meal
- b/ after every meal
- c/ after toilette
- d/ before going out to the garden
- e/ after coming back from the garden
- f/ always as needed during the course of the day

Assurance of individual personal belongings:

- comb, towel each child has his/her own, labeled by a mark, which has been assigned to him/her on the first day in the children's group
 the comb is washed once per week
- towel is changed twice a week, more often if needed
- washcloth goes to the laundry immediately after use
 - chamber pot is washed and disinfected every day

2% chloramine is used for disinfection, and everything is rinsed afterwards.

Children's meals

There is a central kitchen in Kotorská. We cook meals suitable from 1 to 3 years of age.

Children are served breakfast as they come, until 8:30 a.m.		
Morning snack	9:00 a.m. – 9:30 a.m.	
Children are served lunch from	11:00 a.m. – gradually per wards	
Afternoon snack	2:30 p.m.	





Weekly diet plan is planned in order to prevent repetition of meals.

Drinking regime

Drinking regime is provided throughout the day. In summer months, children are served drinks also in the garden.

types of drinks:

water, milk, coffee with milk, tea with milk, hot cocoa, fruit teas
